THE ENGINE'S BROAD TORQUE BAND MEANT THAT POWER WAS READILY AVAILABLE ACROSS THE REV RANGE, MAKING IT EQUALLY ADEPT AT RELAXED CRUISING AND SPIRITED DRIVING.

THE IMPORTANCE OF THE MANUAL TRANSMISSION

FOR MANY ENTHUSIASTS, THE MANUAL TRANSMISSION IS THE DEFINING FEATURE OF THE 1994 BMW 325IS. OWNING A MANUAL 325IS MEANT ACTIVELY PARTICIPATING IN THE DRIVING PROCESS, RATHER THAN SIMPLY BEING A PASSENGER.

CHASSIS DYNAMICS AND HANDLING PROWESS

BMW has long been synonymous with exceptional chassis tuning, and the 1994 BMW 325is manual is a prime example of this dedication. THE 325IS MODEL OFTEN FEATURED SUBTLE YET EFFECTIVE AERODYNAMIC ENHANCEMENTS, SUCH AS A MORE AGGRESSIVE FRONT SPOILER AND A SMALL REAR DECKLID SPOILER, WHICH NOT ONLY IMPROVED AIRFLOW BUT ALSO SIGNALED ITS SPORTIER INTENT. THE OVERALL DESIGN IS A TESTAMENT TO BMW'S ABILITY TO CREATE VEHICLES THAT ARE BOTH FUNCTIONAL AND BEAUTIFUL.

AERODYNAMIC ENHANCEMENTS
