For instance, in some specific raid compositions or for certain solo content, players might shift a point or two to gain access to different buffs or utility. Stat Prioritization and Gearing for Elemental Shamans

Reaching the spell hit cap is non-negotiable for raiding. For a level 83 boss, you need 17% spell hit. This is achieved through a combination of talents (Elemental Precision grants 3%), raid buffs (like Improved Divine Spirit from a Discipline Priest), and gear. Aim to get as close to the cap as possible through your gear choices, then use talents and buffs to reach it. Missing spells significantly reduces your overall damage.

Gearing Strategy: From Badges to Raid Drops

Your gearing journey will likely start with badge gear from various 5-man dungeons and heroic instances. As you progress, you'll move into raid gear from Ulduar, Trial of the Crusader, and Icecrown Citadel. Prioritize items

that offer Spell Power, followed by Hit Rating until the cap, then Haste and Critical Strike Rating. Don't overlook trinkets, as they can provide substantial damage increases through their on-use or passive effects.

Rotation and Key Abilities for Elemental Shamans

A strong understanding of your spell rotation is crucial for maximizing your damage output. Elemental Shamans have a dynamic rotation that emphasizes maintaining damage-over-time effects and weaving in powerful direct damage spells.

Maintaining Flame Shock and Lava Burst

Flame Shock is your primary damage-over-time (DoT) spell. It's vital to keep Flame Shock applied to your target at all times. Ensure you cast Lava Burst whenever it's available, prioritizing it over other spells when possible.

- **Opener:** Pre-cast Lava Burst before the pull, then begin with Lightning Bolt or Chain Lightning (depending on group size and mana).
- **Maintain DoTs:** Keep Flame Shock applied to the target.
- **Spam Spells:** Use Chain Lightning for multiple targets or when Elemental Mastery is active. Use Lightning Bolt as your primary single-target filler spell.

Elemental Overload and Procs

Elemental Overload is a passive talent that gives your Lightning Bolt and Lava Burst a chance to trigger another spell of the same type for free, with no cooldown. This is a significant damage increase and can lead to chains of critical hits. Maximizing the uptime of spells that can proc Elemental Overload is key.

Gems, Enchants, and Glyphs

To further optimize your Elemental Shaman, you'll want to utilize the best gems, enchants, and glyphs available in WotLK.

Gemming Strategy

Gemming should align with your stat priorities. Generally, you'll want to prioritize meta gems that require specific socket bonuses, followed by Spell Power and then a mix of Haste and Critical Strike.

Enchanting Your Gear

Enchants are crucial for squeezing out the last bits of performance from your gear.

- **Head:** Arcanum of Burning Mysteries (+ Spell Power and + Crit Rating)

- **Shoulders:** Greater Inscription of Flame (+ Spell Power and + Crit Rating)
- **Cloak:** Greater Speed (+ Movement Speed) or Spell Penetration if fighting spell-resistant mobs.
- **Chest:** Enchant Chest - Powerful Stats (+10 Stats)
- **Bracers:** Enchant Bracer - Greater Spell Power (+30 Spell Power)
- **Gloves:** Enchant Gloves - Spell Power (+28 Spell Power) or Enchant Gloves - Spell Penetration (+10 Spell Penetration)
- **Waist:** Belt of Blasting (adds Spell Power and Fire Damage)
- **Legs:** Brilliant Spellthread (+52 Spell Power and +20 Stamina)
- **Boots:** Enchant Boots - Tuskarr's Vitality (+15 Stamina, + Movement Speed) or Enchant Boots - Greater Spell Power (+15 Spell Power)
- **Weapon:** Enchant Weapon - Mighty Spellpower (+63 Spell Power) or Enchant Weapon - Lesser Wizard's Blessing (+45 Spell Power).

Key Glyphs

Glyphs offer significant passive benefits and should be chosen carefully.

- **Prime Glyphs:** Glyph of Lightning Bolt (Increases Lightning Bolt damage by 5%), Glyph of Chain Lightning (Increases Chain Lightning damage by 5%), Glyph of Lava Burst (Increases Lava Burst damage by 5%).
- **Minor Glyphs:** Glyph of Water Shield (Increases max mana by 1%), Glyph of Reincarnation (Allows you to use Reincarnation more often), Glyph of the Fire Elemental (Makes your Fire Elemental Totem last longer).

Threat Management and Survivability

As a ranged caster, managing threat and staying alive are crucial for your group's success and your own uptime.

Threat Generation

Elemental Shamans can generate significant threat, especially during AoE pulls or when a tank is undergeared. Your primary threat-generating spells are Chain Lightning and Lightning Bolt. Learn to manage your threat by observing your threat meter and backing off your damage when necessary, especially on burn phases or when the tank is struggling.

Utilizing Water Shield and Shield Wall
